

1. The enemy is a liar.

BEWARE of the LIAR! Stay out of the TRAP!

The enemy does not get real creative. He uses what has always worked, so we hear the same lies over and over again. A stronghold is created when he speaks a lie and it is believed. Some may even sound silly, but when their "breathing down your neck," a lie can be confusing and even compelling. It's the truth that sets the captive free...so imagine what a lie does!
