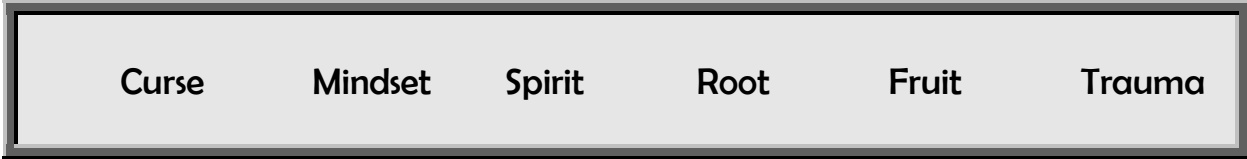

- Not content and satisfied.
- No Joy when Giving
- Settling for a mate because you do not deserve better or this is the "last one.
- Will not use what you have for fear it is the last.
- Worry about Provision
- Resenting the Wealthy
- Perceived Inferiority
- Perceived Inadequacies
- Hoarding
- Criticizing others or organizations for spending money they have.
- Not tithing or offering to the Lord
- You feel like you have to justify purchased you make.
- Always borrowing and not the lender.
- God will give to others, but not me.
- Guilt for having money or things
- Buy for 50 bucks and sell for 25.
- Don't find deals like others.
- Having extra money is consuming and has to spend.
- Cannot enjoy what you already have.
- Irritation at those who do not have poverty mindset
- Hopelessness
- Never ending loop of not enough
- Perpetual bad decisions concerning finances.
- Mind consumed with winning lottery or quick wealth.
- One step forward and two steps back.
- Can't seem to get ahead.
- Things tearing up constantly and many times multiple things at one time.

Root: At the Root of Issues that Trauma from Poverty can cause

Read Exodus 16 and 17 and see which of their issues are related to the mindsets they had formed in Egypt while in captivity and poverty. These fruit issues are not unlike the issues that people today get when they have experienced poverty.

Breaking FREE: Things you can do to help break through and stay free.

- Pray
- Repent
- Expose Fear
- Ask the Lord where your mind needs renewed. (Reveal residue of Trauma)
- Renounce lies and patterns of poverty.
- Ask the Lord if you need to make restoration and if so, pray about how to do it.
- Ask the Lord to reveal any hindrances to being set free from poverty.
- Renounce any sins relating to poverty or ancestral patterns in your family.
- Cultivate patterns of giving in faith.
- Gain wisdom on handling finances
- Use scripture to help you change your thought processes.
- Command any spirit in operation concerning poverty to go immediately.

Confession
